Care Instructions and species information:

Will grow to 15-20 ft. in 5-10 years. Can tolerate wind, heat, but not drought tolerant until established. (Then it will be drought tolerant only where there is a high water table or along the coast.) Likes sun and moderate water. Plant at 15 deg. angle for sweep, or pull over with cables to encourage spreading habit. This is a very important wildlife plant. Hummingbirds and butterflies use extensively. It is a food plant for the Western Tiger Swallowtail.
